## **NOSE NOTE:**

Jamaica marks its territory from the outset. We enter the world of English rhum, full-bodied and fragrant, where very ripe exotic fruits reign supreme. A few oxidized, roasted nuts provide the backdrop, walnuts in particular offering beautiful relief and density.

Aeration gradually replaces the fruity, tropical air to reveal much deeper notes of prunes and walnuts. It's Guyana talking now, reminding us of the heyday of British Navy rums.



## PALATE NOTE:

Powerful, punchy, with a certain fatness that immediately reassures.

It oscillates between the pleasant acidity of Jamaican rums swollen with dunder, and the rough, powdery texture of old Demerara.

A fine concentration of fruit shines through, encased in a well-toasted cask whose wood exudes maple syrup, cooked sugar and soy sauce.



## **FINISH NOTE:**

Powerful and long, on liquorice molasses, with a touch of walnut that coats the palate.
