## **NOSE NOTE:**

Right from the start, the Jamaican part of the blend takes over. The very ripe exotic fruits are unmistakable.

A certain organic side brings us closer to the work of these emblematic distilleries, known for making rhum the way nobody makes it anymore.

Balance remains the order of the day, thanks to a softer, caramelized veil derived from American oak. Aeration leads to a delicious pastry register dominated by almond and kirsch. Notes of pine resin join those of candied cherries, but without becoming excessively sweet. The copper of the still tightens the profile, which even evolves on mineral notes of gunflint.



## PALATE NOTE:

Greediness cuts through power. Immediately after an organic, fermentative attack, frangipane and cherry bring a debauchery of comforting pastry flavors. Butterscotch is the perfect complement to the rum's brioche flavors. Dried banana rubs shoulders with tobacco and vanilla to melt us for good.



## FINISH NOTE:

Long and pastry-like, with hints of resin and copper.
