

## PRODUCT INFORMATION:

This whisky was peacefully aged in two old Sauternes casks from a magnificent estate on the banks of the Ciron.

**TOPAZE** matured for many months in one of the convent's damp cellars before being blended.

Voluntarily left at a higher degree to best express all the character of this single malt and necessary for a high quality whisky.

This single malt was bottled by gravity, without filtration or coloring, at 53 %.

STRENGTH: 53 % vol.

**VOLUME**: 50 cl







## **NOSE NOTE:**

Gourmet, with notes of custard, cookie, vanilla and honeysuckle.

After aeration, quince paste, ripe mirabelle plum and peach-in-syrup fragrances emerge.

A very summery nose.



## PALATE NOTE:

Round and full-bodied, the slight reduction gives the whisky plenty of fullness without any hint of aggressiveness.

Honey, yellow fruit and marzipan are present: very sweet.

A few vinous notes bring the tasting to a close.



## **FINISH NOTE:**

Long, suave, with hints of marzipan and dried fruit.

Warm, comforting notes.
